



Season's Greetings from Donghua University - 3 weeks' summer textile program are now open for register

Donghua University will launch a textile-related program: Advanced Seminar or Textile Industry International Cooperation in Production Capacity (BR-ASTI), featuring "Exploring the Frontiers and Enhancing Academics". It is open to international students majored in textile engineering, or those who are working in the industry.

BR-ASTI has been continuously carried out by Donghua University for several years since 2017. Before the pandemic, participants were university students, faculty members, entrepreneurs, etc. from Donghua University's overseas partner universities, or domestic and overseas partner enterprises. Questionnaires showed the feedback kept positive all the time.

The way of participating this summer will mainly be face to face, and the admitted participants are welcome to Donghua campus to join in person; However, some parts will be available online. Therefore, those who are interested, whether within or outside of the mainland China, can choose to participate online or offline according to their own circumstances. It should be noted that, at present, people staying outside of mainland China can only choose to participate the online part.

BR-ASTI is funded by the Shanghai Municipal Government, and the admitted participants can join basically for free. Anyone who are interested can scan the QR code below to register his/her interest, and will be contacted by Donghua University later this month for formal application and admission.
